Albyn Housing LDCI need to decide what to do with the land around the houses. Options include community garden, grassland. Issue with on-going maintenance. Brora, Helmsdale have got funding for 2 part-time gardeners. Benches to be sited at the front of the properties facing the loch. Compass contract gardeners to replace lost trees.

Highland Council haven't adopted the road. Albyn Housing having a discussion re waste services/maintaining the road.
